

Tytherington In The Pink



For the fifth year running, Tytherington High School held its Pink Week between the 18th and the 22nd October to raise money for breast cancer charities. Students and staff worked together to organise and participate in a range of fundraising events during the course of the week. The whole school took part in a non-uniform day and students paid £1 each for the privilege of wearing their own clothes on this day. Other activities involved a staff raffle, numerous cake sales organised and run by the students and the sale of pink badges. The week culminated in a tense, nail-biting staff vs. sixth form hockey match which ended in a 1:1 draw.

Tytherington staff and students raised a total of £2,200 this year to make the overall amount raised by the school over the last five years to a staggering £10,000 for Cancer Research UK, Breast Cancer Care and Breast Cancer Campaign, the three breast cancer charities supported by the school.
