Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that school will close at 1.50 p.m. on the last day of term, Tuesday, 21st December. We have arranged for school buses to leave the site by 2.00 p.m. so that students should arrive home approximately 90 minutes earlier than normal.

This is also an opportunity for me to remind you that the temporary arrangements for the leadership of the school that have been in place since October 2009 will continue until the end of the current academic year as agreed with Cheshire East Council. At the beginning of September 2011, I will revert to my substantive post as Headteacher and Mr Harrison will return as my Deputy with other staff also returning to their substantive posts. For the next two terms, I will continue to support Mr Harrison in his post as Acting Headteacher of Macclesfield High School for the equivalent of one day each week but the remainder of my time will be focussed on leading and managing Tytherington High.

In the New Year, governors are planning to provide opportunities for you to contribute to planning the future strategic direction of the school, taking account of the changing national and local contexts. This will include giving serious consideration to the opportunities offered by the Academy programme and identifying and managing the implications of the decision to retain four high schools in the town. Preliminary discussions have also taken place with officers of Cheshire East Council to plan and deliver the major capital building project primarily aimed at replacing temporary accommodation and improving access to ICT on our school site. We anticipate that work will begin on the buildings towards the end of the Summer term 2011 and be completed for the start of the 2012/13 academic year.
