Dear Parents/Carers,

During the course of the year, we encourage all members of our community to support selected charities. The focus for this autumn term is two charities who work in combating the effects of cancer.

Later in the term, we will be holding a number of events linked to breast cancer awareness. These usually culminate in a 'wear something pink' own clothes day during which a staff v 6th form hockey match takes place.

Our other main cancer charity is the Macmillan Appeal. In order to support this worthy cause the students are given the opportunity to take part in a 'coffee morning', which is organised by the students in Ash House.

We would also like to give the staff an opportunity to participate in a Macmillan Coffee Morning. We introduced this event last year and raised a considerable amount of money as a result.

Our fund-raising coffee morning for staff has been scheduled for **Friday 24 September**. In order to accommodate this, **morning registration will start at 9.45am** instead of 8.45am. Periods 2 – 5 will then run as normal. **We have arranged for our school buses to pick up at all the usual stops an hour later than normal on this day.** If, for any reason, you would still prefer your son/daughter to arrive at school prior to 9.40am, the Refectory will be open to students from 8.00am and they will be able to sit inside and buy drinks/breakfast as usual. The slightly late start has the added advantage that students who are involved in the open evening get a slightly longer rest and it gives staff some time to complete the 'tidying up' in order that the school is ready for normal lessons.

School will **finish at the normal time of 3.20pm** on Friday 24 September and buses will collect and drop off in the usual way.
